Tournament Rules

ADMISSIONS WILL BE CHARGED AT THE DOOR \$5 FOR SPECTATORS

- The tournament will be bowled on Saturday November 9th and will start at 9:00AM. Teams or bowlers who are late will receive zeros until they arrive. Teams need to check-in 45 minutes prior.
- During the 3 games of individual play, teams will bowl 5 bowlers.
- Team are limited to a roster of 6 bowlers. Teams may enter more than one team, but each team must have its own roster. Rosters are due by October 31st.
- Teams will bowl 4 baker games and may make a sub at any time, but once a bowler is removed, they may not return until the next game.
- After both the individual and baker portions, the top 4 teams with the highest 19 game total will be seeded into the semi-final round. All ties will be broken by using the team with the higher baker total. If a team is not present at the start of match play the next team in the standing will move up.
- Once team make the match play bracket, they will bowl best 2 of 3 matches. In the case of a tie the teams will continue with the series and bowl a 4th game if needed.
- All other issues will be decided upon by the tournament director, Bill Carter.
